

# How your vote can help deliver even better for Stonydelph and Glascoate

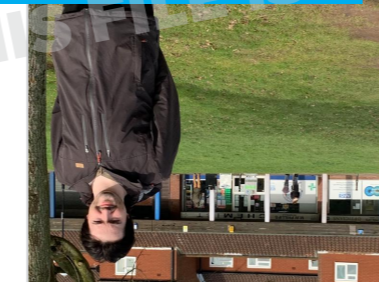

## 1 Tackling congestion hotspots

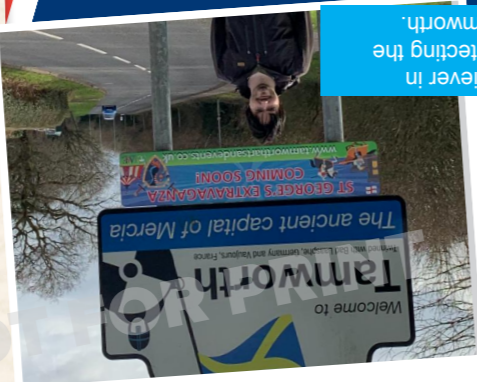
